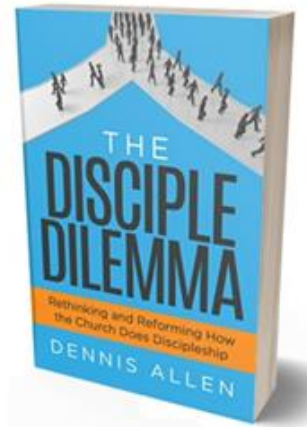

Your destiny - as a disciple: “Follow” Christ, keep maturing, encourage others to do the same

- Hebrews 5:12
- 2nd Timothy 2:2-14
- 1st Thessalonians 2:10-13
- 1st Peter 5:1-2

Being expert/experienced/old/educated: *NOT* a prerequisite in discipling

- The “awakening” of King Josiah and his priests - changing a flawed culture:
2nd Chronicles 34 and 2nd Kings 22
- King Asa changes a broken culture:
1st Kings 15 & 2nd Chronicles 14

Team up / (Leaders: Exhort people) to disciple, together, in work / community / home life

- Ecclesiastes 4:9
- Mark 6:7
- Luke 10:11
- Proverbs 27:17
- Proverbs 29:18

The surroundings [culture] of a believer’s “soil” matters! What is *your* church culture like?

- Matthew 13:18-23 & Mark 4:2-22
[Consider the surroundings too, not just “the soil”]

A community of disciples: very different than the societies around them

- 2nd Corinthians 2:15
